Sick Leave Usage: Practice and Policy

- Please book local appointments around the school day bookends if possible. A teacher will be deducted only the exact time away from the school work day even though it costs the employer more for the TTOC
- For Specialist appointments, the employer acknowledges there is little flexibility with times.
- Full days should not be used for appointments in local area (Penticton)
- Admin have the right to ask questions pertaining to sick leave; teachers have the right not to disclose specific medical details. Use your discretion and if unclear, seek advice from union president.

Relief Costs (TTOCs and EAs) continue to be 30% more than the employer budgeted. This will impact the next year's budget; have your say, voice your concern on the SD budget survey.
